Mother that Came from the Sea.... Article 3: The Devotion to Our Lady

Devotion means to donate or to give of oneself. Saint Thomas Aquinas taught that "true devotion is the complete surrender to our Lord," and St. John Paul II wrote in the Apostolic Rosarium Virgins Mariae Letter: "the most perfect of all the devotions is the one that incontestably confirms, joins and consecrates us to Jesus Christ." Being that Mary is the

Mother of Jesus Christ, it stands to reason that, among all the devotions, the one that most surrender's one's soul to our Lord, is the devotion to Mary. The more one consecrates him/herself to Her, the more he/she will be consecrated to Jesus Christ.

Since the early years of the Church, Marian devotion has existed. In the New Testament we note the love and deep respect that Jesus' disciples had shown Mary; especially from the moment She received the Maternal mission from Her Son at Calvary: "Here's Your Son – Here's Your Mother."

Mary is the spiritual Mother of the Church and the true faithful's devotion is one that comes from the Spirit and from the heart; devotion which comes from estimation and faith in Her, from the deep awareness of Her magnitude and the daughterly love that She conveys.

"Every day, look for Mary's protection, mother of the Lord and mirror of His Holiness: She will help you to be a faithful disciple of Her Son Jesus"

True devotion to Mary is filled with faith and total abandonment to Her. Faith and total abandonment approach the person in his needs of body and soul, and he does so with the simplicity of a child; knowing that he is never alone as he has a vigilant and attentive Mother, ready to support him, advise him, guide him, protecting him and providing assurance. Encountering our Lady, relying on Her, asking for Her protection, receiving

consolation and assurance, are all things that guide the pilgrim to Marian Shrines. With her gaze, she tells all of them, "Don't be afraid, open your hearts to my Son, do what He tells you. We will always be with you and never abandon you."

Aside from all the various expressions beyond devotional practices and traditions, such as kissing or touching her image, making pilgrimages, following the procession barefoot, wearing symbolic clothing, offering flowers, etc. true devotion occurs in the imitation of Mary's virtues, modeling maternity, discipleship, compassion and total surrender to God's will.


St. Joseph Ministry Fair
